
## Standard Elementary Drum Rudiments

FOR BAND AND ORCHESTRA

Every student of drums should know the standard elementary drum rudiments before attempting to play in the band or orchestra.

Start each rudiment slowly, increase the speed to your capability, then decrease to the starting point.





Use the practice pad in all your rudimental studies. Note the holding of the sticks-especially the left hand.

The rudiments are practiced on a rubber practice pad. Start each rudiment very slowly, increasing the speed very gradually to close the rudiment, then open gradually, slower and slower to the starting point. This develops control of the sticks.



The Double Stroke, or Long Roll, is most important and the basic rudiment, and should have careful attention and study. The student should provide himself with a reliable instruction book (Moeller Book No. 697, published by Ludwig & Ludwig - \$2.00) even though private instructions are recommended.
