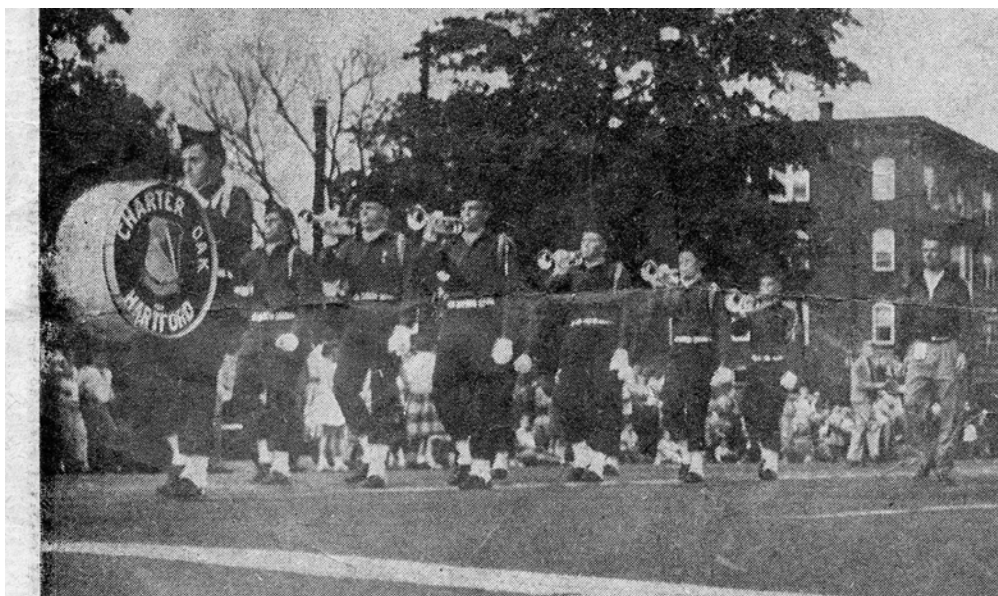
Hartford Boy Scouts, Memorial Day parade Hartford Connecticut.
